### MAESTRO SOFTWARE OPTION (NETWORK VERSIONS)

---

#### DESCRIPTION

Cansec's Remote Management option provides a means of performing administrative functions for up to 10 remote sites running **Maestro** Security Management Software from **anywhere**. Using Remote Management Client (RMC) software, system administrators are able to connect via dial-up modem or TCP/IP (Internet / Intranet) to perform tasks such as manage cardholders, run reports, view reader and point status icons, issue reader and point commands, and edit various system setup parameters. Up to 10 Remote Management Clients may be connected to a remote site concurrently.

#### APPLICATIONS

The Remote Management option provides an effective means of managing a **Maestro** system from a remote location. The local **Maestro** system may be manned or unmanned. Unlike generic "remote control" software packages which simply take over local operations of the PC, each RMC connection operates concurrently and seamlessly with the local **Maestro** software.

This option is most effective when used in conjunction with Maestro's Alarm Activated Pager option as well as Maestro's Remote Alarm Server option. **MaestroPage** allows alarms from an unmanned **Maestro** system to be transmitted to an alphanumeric pager. On receipt of an alarm, the RMC software can be initiated to display the status of all devices at the site and perform any required administration and control functions.

With the Remote Alarm Server option, alarms may be received and annunciated at a remote location which could also be running the RMC software. Once the alarm is selected within the Remote Alarm Client software, the administrator can easily connect to the remote system using the RMC software. Use of these options in conjunction can result in significant manpower savings.
